

End of July Financial Glance

There are 126 congregations active in the life of the Christian Church in North Carolina. So far, this year *more than half*, 65 congregations, have participated through financial partnership in the ministries of the Christian Church in North Carolina.

DISCIPLE MISSION FUND - This is the main source of funding for the ministries conducted by the Christian Church in North Carolina. This fund supports all the ministries of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). The Region receives ½ of DMF given



by North Carolina congregations. The last three months have seen increases in DMF giving each month. 48 congregations have shared in this Fund. So far, this year CCNC has received \$78,816.41 from DMF.

SPECIAL OFFERINGS - These are opportunities through the year to support specific and designated ministries of the church. So far, this year 24 congregations have chosen this option for giving. \$9,106 of those offerings were for the 2016 Christmas Offering which comes to the Christian Church in North Carolina.

DESIGNATED GIVING - Designated offerings are those given with a specific recipient named. They are not divided nor is any money given to anything other than the designee. 31 congregations this year have given gifts designated for either the Christian Church in North Carolina or Camp Caroline. That has amounted to \$47,234.66.
