## Preparing for the Long Term

Recovery from Florence will not happen over night. We can expect months and potentially years for a complete recovery.

Now is the time for your church community to seriously consider the questions, "How can we be the hands and feet of Christ in the weeks and months to come?" Below are some questions for your consideration:

#### How Will We Respond in the Short Term and Longer Term

- Do we have the space to be a collection/distributions site? [i.e. items such as cleanup kits, food from/for food banks, construction supplies, shipments from other communities, etc.]
- What financial resources can we contribute? [i.e. outreach budgets, special offerings, fundraisers - Week of Compassion is our disaster relief arm and they are AMAZING!]
- How might we support work teams? [i.e. Can our church provide housing, meals, tools, construction materials, etc.]

- What special skills do our members have? [i.e. Do we have members who can volunteer their time at shelters, interfaiths, helping organize volunteers, etc.]
- Can we provide work teams? [i.e. all skill levels will be needed from mucking to construction]
- How can we make our facility available beyond collection and storage? [i.e. provide meals, provide chaplaincy & counseling services, open our space to FEMA, Red Cross, etc]
- Can we provide Canvas Teams? [i.e. teams to go out and canvas hard hit areas to see the damage and the needs, provide needs assessment. This most likely will require training.]

These are just a few questions for your church to consider, there are unlimited ways for your congregation to make a difference. This is a time when we can show others the love that God has shown to us.
